

## Academic Grading System

At Nova International School, our grading system is based on subject end of unit tests and 2 exams in Semester 1 and 2 exams in Semester 2.

The weighting of the grading for each semester works as follows:

## The weight of the grades are:

| Average of all end of Unit Tests $=$ | $10 \%$ |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Mid-Term Tests | $=10 \%$ |
| End of Semester Exam | $=80 \%$ |
| Final Grade | $=100 \%$ |

*Students are required to fulfil all their assignments, homework and classwork, if student has not completed his coursework the semester grade will be downgraded.

End of Unit Tests are either prepared by the Teacher, or are either American Common Core (Grades 1 to 3), British Cambridge International Examinations standardized tests.

Some subjects do not have standardized tests like Arabic and Religious Studies. These subjects' tests are prepared by the Teacher, and checked by the Primary and High School Principals.

The Grading Scale looks as follows:
